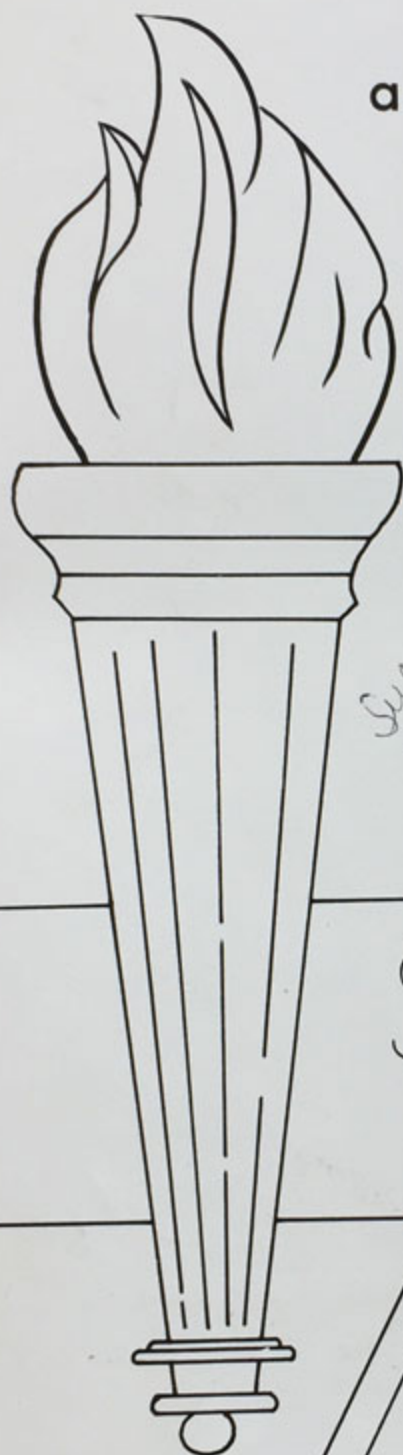

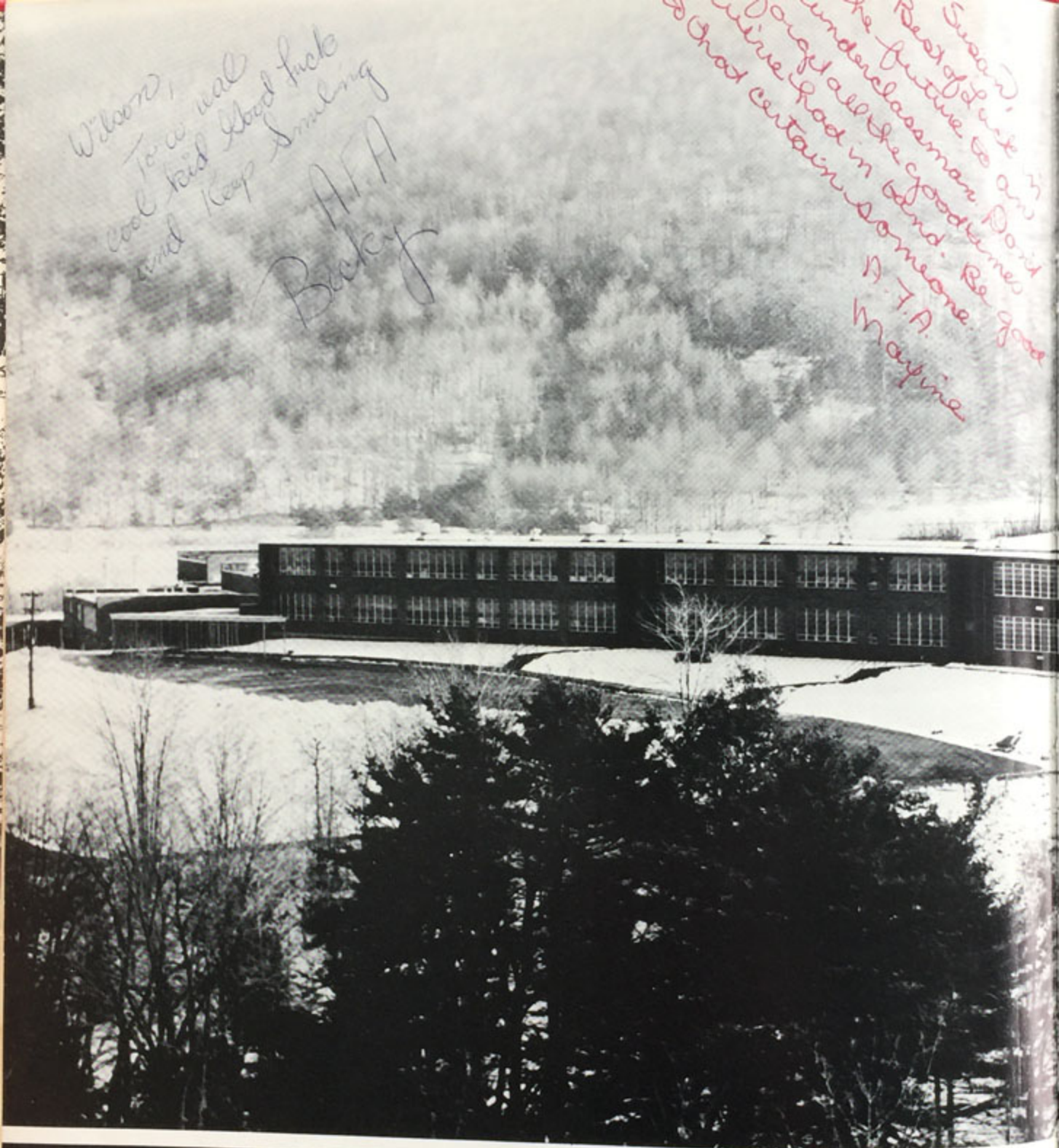

Of course, there is also a large bulletin board filled with school news or a student's best work.

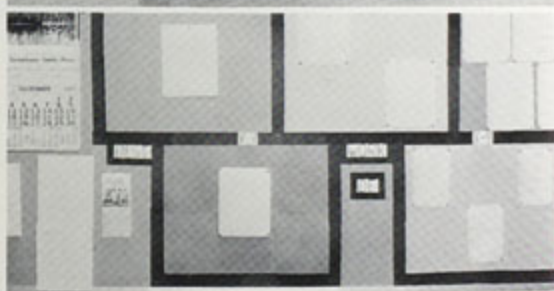
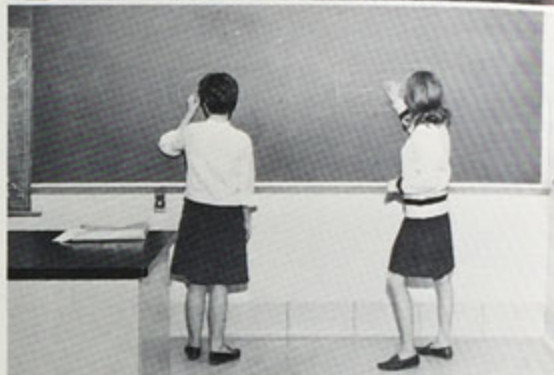
Another distinctive area is the earth science room. In this room are located a small lab area, geographical equipment, and earth science apparatus.
