




On July 1, 1952, six districts decided to form a jointure for their mutual educational benefit. Those districts — New Milford, Hallstead, Great Bend, Jackson and New Milford and Great Bend Townships — each were to supply five school directors. After a five-year investigation and discussion, a site was selected in 1957. To keep the honor and glory of the graduation moment, for a decade teachers at the high school purposed to lock boredom and prejudice outside the classroom door; administrators sought to maintain harmony through unbiased judgments; students faced with the awesome responsibility of making a new school work, listened to the dictates of their hearts, softened their surging zeal for their former schools, and, for the most part, complied with the rules. As a result of community effort, in 1959 the name Blue Ridge High School served as a link to join these communities in education. The man most responsible for unifying the six districts into a smoothly functioning organization was Wayne C. Webster, a quiet, unassuming, yetstraight forward man who did much for our school community.







It is rather the realization that so many Blue Ridge graduates have left our school, gone out and found success in the world. Students who have left our school and gone on to higher education have been extremely successful in their endeavors. The percentage of graduates who have decided to go on to higher education is in itself noteworthy. These students have not found college as difficult as others have because of their training at Blue Ridge. The seeds of determination and stamina, which were sown at Blue Ridge, resulted in success for the majority of those who went to colleges or trade schools. As a result, many of these young people have found high paying jobs and have been successful in their careers. Many are grade and high school teachers; at least one is now teaching in a college. Those who have left our commercial and vocational departments have met with similar success. They now hold well paying jobs and have found satisfaction from their endeavors. For the most part, the Blue Ridge graduates of the last ten years all have one thing in common - all have found success, enjoyment and fulfillment in their lives. How much of this success can be attributed to Blue Ridge High School is a matter of conjecture, but the facts remain the same.

Wholehearted student support has backed the efforts of the administration in making Blue Ridge a better place in which to study, because these attempts include constant change and reaching toward the intangible goals of unity and of school spirit. Her achievements represent a better-educated people, and her progress is continual growth. It is to these concepts that we, the student body of Blue Ridge High School, dedicate this yearbook for 1969 to a "Decade At Blue Ridge High School".




#### HOWARD F. C. THOMAS, Superintendent
