This new building will house kindergarten through fourth grade and will be situated directly behind the present junior-senior high school. The bids came in at approximately \$3,000,000 for a facility that will contain 22 regular classrooms, three kindergartens, a special education room, a music room, an art room, and a multi-purpose room (gym). The instructional materials center (library) will be the heart of the school. The ground floor of one wing will contain administrative offices and a health suite. An extra large cafeteria will provide the necessary space to feed the pupils from both this building and the present junior-senior high school. There will be an enclosed passage way between both schools. Adequate storage room has been provided. The pod-type design was used to eliminate much of the wasted corridor space found in many buildings. An on-site sewage disposal plant will service both buildings. It was estimated that it will take eighteen months to build and will hopefully be completed by September 1, 1976.

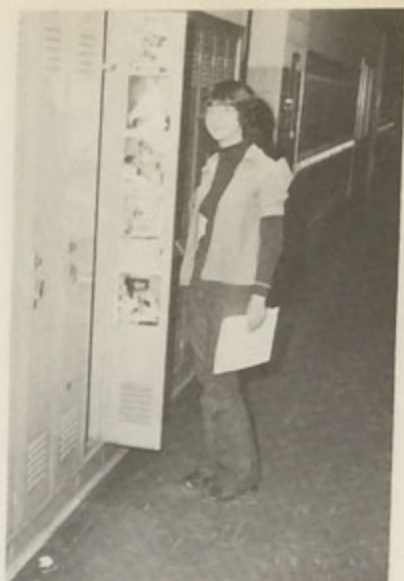
