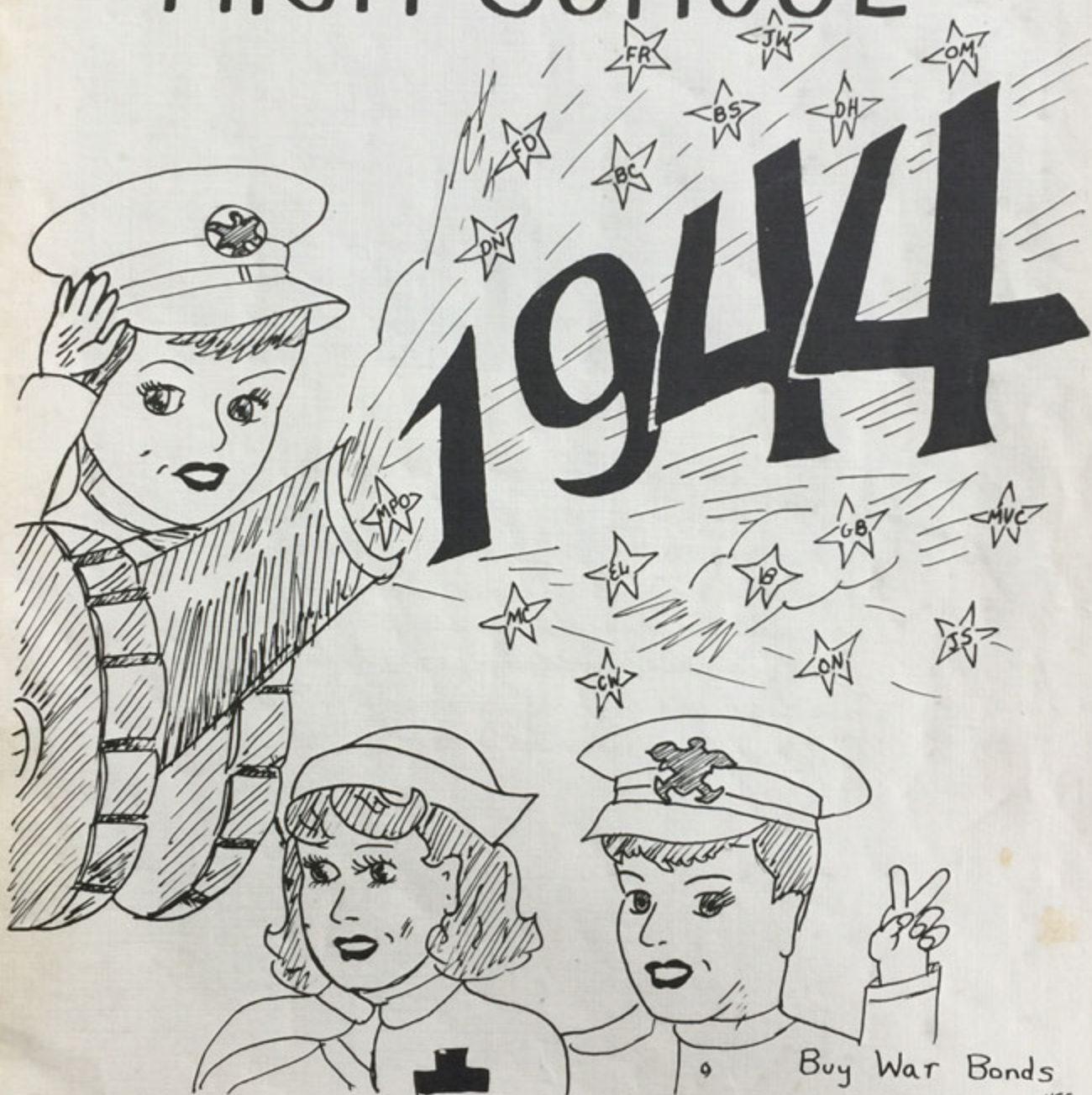

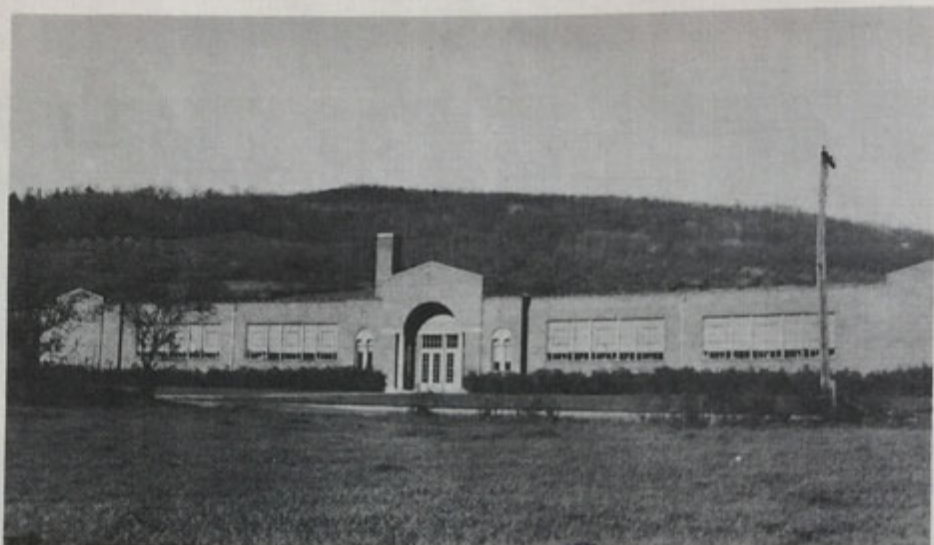
### *Dedication*

#### ALMA MATER

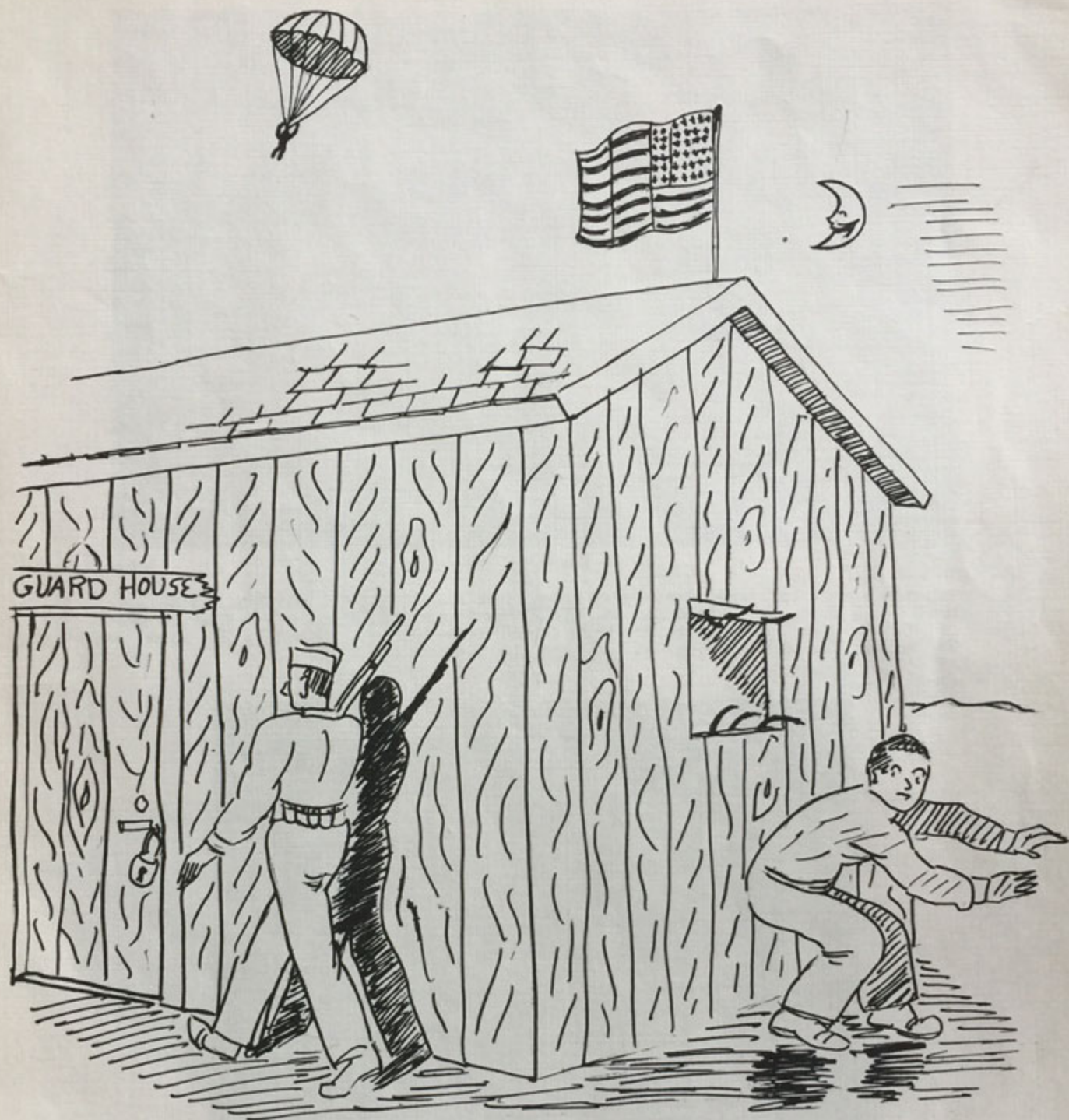
On the trail and in the valley,

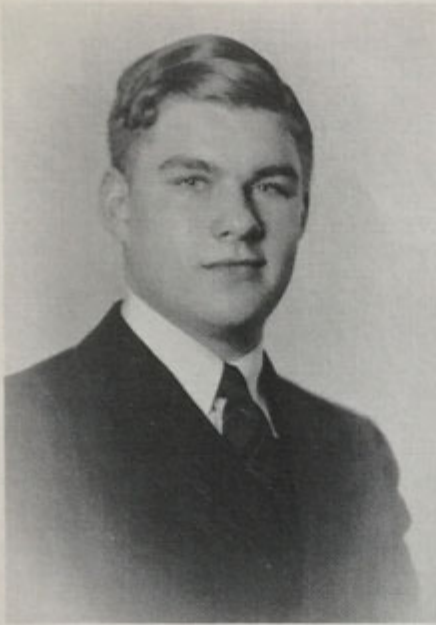

And of men she isn't leery.

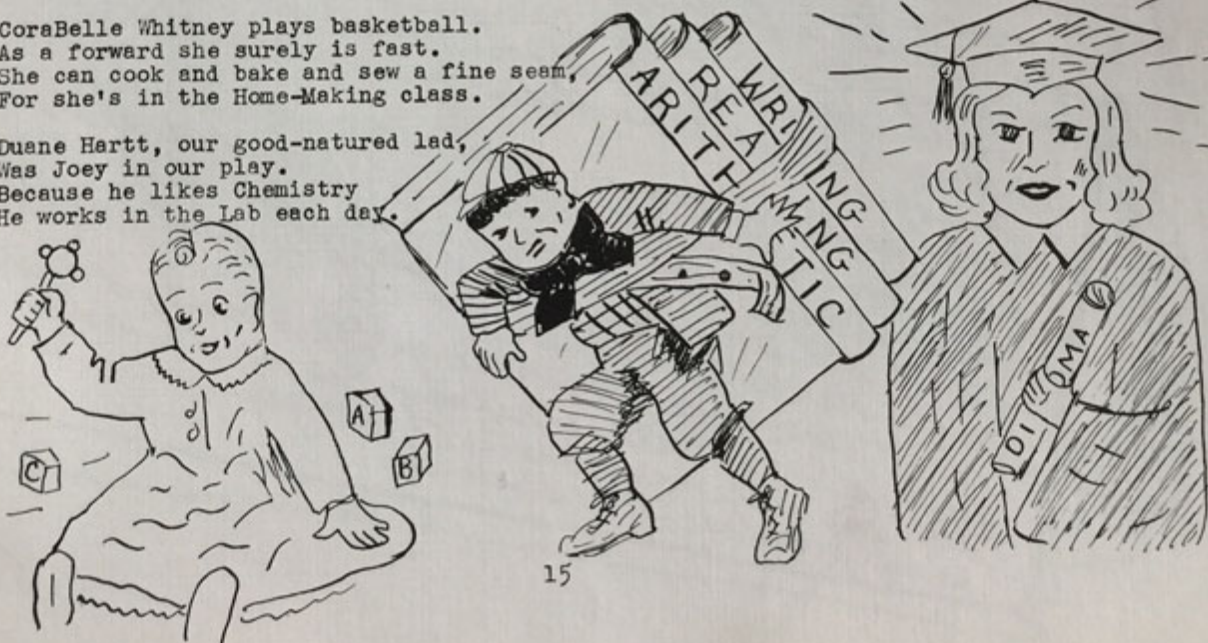
Next is Olga Nesevitch
